Texas Autism Supplement RECAP

- <u>§89.1055</u> Commissioner's Rules Concerning Special Education Services
- Texas Autism Supplement is a document and a process
- It encompasses 11 strategies (since last modification in 2007)
- Strategies use for interventions must be peer-reviewed and research based
- Their considerations by ARD-C does not imply implementation



Strategy 3. In-Home & Community Based Training

- Maintenance/Generalization/Transferring of skills
- Provided by qualified personnel with experience in Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD)
- The goals of both parent training and inhome training are to provide a continuity of interventions from school to home that will assist the child in generalizing skills learned at school to the home.
- ARD-C determines service and frequency

Strategy 6. Parent/Family Training and Support

- Provided by qualified personnel with experience in autism spectrum disorders.
- It might include simple supports such as an interactive notebook between the school and the parents, printed materials, and websites. It might also include workshops or conferences.
- Facilitates parental carryover of in-home training
- A school should provide information regarding local resources available to parents/families of students with autism.
- Training should focus on generalization of IEP-related skills and include areas such as behavior management, interpersonal skills, communication training and/or structured environments across all settings.

Strategy 10. Professional/ Educator - Staff Support

- Training and support for professional and staff working with your child to assure the correct implementation of techniques and strategies described in the IEP.
- Schools are responsible for training teachers and paraprofessionals to effectively implement programs for students with autism. Training may include a foundation of scientifically-based research interventions/strategies
- The supplement does not mandate a specific degree or credential.

- Discrete Trial Learning, ABA and/or social skills training, visual supports, augmentative communication
- Based on peer reviewed and/or research based practices for students with ASD
- The inclusion of a strategy in TAC 89.1055(e)(11) should not be misinterpreted as an endorsement of any particular methodology

- It is the LEA's responsibility to train, or ensure, that professional educators and staff are trained in peer-reviewed and evidence-based practices specific to ASD.
